



This time may be an opportunity to create some transition tools, organize, create new ways to achieve our goals, renew, revitalize, and for an old Knight to learn new tricks.

I am so grateful to all the brother Knights that have been so generous with their time and talents, and have come to my rescue when I call. Thank you. Pray for me. I will persevere.

Keeps accurate records of the council's Faith programs for reporting to the Program Director, along with completing reports for the Refund Vocations Support (RSVP).

Appointed annually by the grand knight. The Director oversees the Council's recruitment and retention activities. Ensures that Membership Applications Form (#100) are transmitted by the Financial Secretary to both the Membership Records Department at the Supreme Council and the general agent.

At LifeSiteNews, Dr. Maike Hickson did an interview with Sr. Lucia dos Santos. Who was one of the three children of Fatima, that saw the Mother of Christ and received secret messages from Our Lady.

According to Hickson, "Sr. Lucia had told him of how our Lady had revealed to her that even the United States of America would be overcome by communism if Russia was not consecrated to Her Immaculate Heart by the pope in union with the world's bishops".

Given the state of affairs today in America and what communism is and its goals for America, the account from Sr. Lucia is truly a striking disclosure.

What we are witnessing today can be described as subversive behavior by some citizens and by some politicians and the media.

The Naked Communist is the most concise and straightforward source outlining communist goals and ideology. It was written in 1962 by W. "*Get control of the schools and use them as transmission belts for socialism. Sorta supports what we are witnessing and are experiencing today in college campuses from liberal professors, even thought their messages are not broadcasted as communist ideals, heaven forbid if they are, but of socialism. *To control teacher's associations, for example: According to Fredick's v. California Teachers Association a 2016

Supreme Court case concerning union dues, Fredick's detailed how the CA Teachers Association (CTA) and the

National Education Association (NEA), which advocate and donate heavily to a wide range of left-wing causes dealing with abortion and transgender issues, work with far-left groups such as the Women's March, the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU), the Southern Poverty Law Center (SPLC), the Gay Lesbian Straight Education Network (GLSEN), and the Sexuality Information and Education Council of the United States (SIECUS) to "push a radical sexual agenda onto our kids and to punish teachers, parents and students who dare to speak out against it." Check out CA AB329 and SB48

Educators and politicians who subscribe to socialists ideology are the oppressors who use manipulation, divide and rule, and support a cultural invasion. These are the tools they use to suppress one's objectivity. Citizens who don't see the reality of our statues and what they represent is a cultural invasion. Oppressed individuals are not able to see problems in in the present tense and the oppressors-liberals—educators/politicians-are feeding on their ignorance.

The Communist Goals or lets say socialists also include: *the Infiltration of the press, which is evident by their everyday news commentaries. They seem to be in control of key positions in radio, TV, and motion pictures, as depicted by their productions to destroy our morals and values. In addition to eliminate statues from parks they are now to desecrating religious symbols.

*Discredit the American Constitution by calling it inadequate, old-fashioned, out of step with modern needs, a hindrance to cooperation between nations on a worldwide basis, as evidenced today by comments made by certain politicians and media. Sound familiar?

* Discredit the American Founding Fathers. Present them as selfish aristocrats who had no concern for the "common man." By taking down statues that remind us of the pain the country went through in building it's democracy and freedom. This is happening as you read this.

*Use student riots to foment public protests against who we are as Americans, our culture, moral believes and what we stand for-Freedom.

*Present homosexuality, degeneracy and promiscuity as "normal, natural, and healthy." Hollywood is a good example of depicting these behaviors

as normal and acceptable in pushing today's standards of morality in their productions. Movies show sexual behavior between two men and frequently between two women substantiates this.

*Support any socialist movement to give centralized control over any part of the culture- education, social agencies, welfare programs, mental health clinics, etc. Think of good old Bernie and the five.

Discredit and eventually dismantle all law enforcement including FBI and CIA. Currently being discussed.

We've gone so far in this direction that counseling is for those wishing to leave the homosexual lifestyle is illegal!

Other goals that are clearly apparent: *Infiltrate the churches and replace revealed religion with "social" religion. This might explain why young adults are leaving the church. There can be no more obvious implementation of this than what has been seen in the Catholic Church in the USA over the few years. Furthermore, they want to discredit the Bible and emphasize the need for intellec-

maturity which does not need a "religious crutch". And are now going after religious symbols.

Their hatred for our society can be heard from the media every day from their liberal guests and pundits. Their hatred for the present administration brings out the best in their commentaries and exposes their liberal thinking of dismantling American ideals.

They go as far as to transferring some of the powers of arrest from the police to social agencies.

These two items together are what we've witnessed since the riots began with the excuse of the tragic death of George Floyd".

Should this be eye-opening to all of us how far these ideals have entered our society?

It would appear that a political party has been infiltrated by the these goals.

Furthermore, the same party has chosen to put blinders on and have so much disdain that they don't want to see the reality of what is going on around them or how they are playing into the dismantling of our FREEDOMS and culture?

Brothers, pay attention and listen to what is happening today! We are in battle to defend who we are as Catholic Christians. The culture of death is emerging. God is becoming less and less important in today's culture. The light is being extinguished. Our faith is being challenged. The defacing, burning and destruction of religious symbols is an indicator of what is to come.
